Matthew 28:18–20

And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

What are we doing here and is it the right thing to do?

The church should constantly be asking this question, but how do we find answers? Is the answer found in financial security? That's important in ministry but it isn't the guideline we use to judge what we do. Is the answer found in full pews? That's important as well, but again it isn't the yardstick by which we measure our ministry.

The Apostle Paul once wrote, "For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast." Our salvation is based on faith, and since the church is about salvation, faithfulness is what we use to judge what we do. Are we being faithful to the Word of God and what God has called us to do?

The work of the church is probably best summarized in Matthew 28:18-20, which we sometimes call the Great Commission. We are called to make disciples. A disciple is someone who learns from, follows, and imitates another. As the church we learn from Christ, follow Him, and imitate Him, to the best of our abilities. But Jesus is clear, not only are we to BE disciples, we are to MAKE disciples.

Here Jesus is very specific on how this is done. We baptize them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, and we teach them to obey the commands of Jesus. We have come to know this as Word and Sacrament ministry.

Baptism and teaching are largely accomplished through the worship life of the congregation. We draw people into our worship life through our witness, and there we baptize them into the family of God. It is in worship that our most important teaching takes place through the liturgy and the reading, singing, and preaching of God's Word. Although Bible study is very important, worship is the life of the church. It is also in worship that we obey God in the most important way as we take and eat the body and blood of Jesus as He commanded us to do.

We have decided to partner with Living Branch Lutheran Church in North Branch in carrying out Word and Sacrament ministry. I'm not sure of all of the options they had, but we were certainly a good option, and I'm glad that we have accepted the call. We have agreed to financially help them by sharing a pastor (me) so that their ministry continues.

Will I be unable to do some of the things that I Have done in the past? Certainly, although at this point, I'm not sure what those things are. But, most importantly, we will be making disciples by baptizing and teaching both here and in North Branch.

What is your part in this? Continue to support the work of Zion. Continue contributing financially to our work. This new financial agreement will enable us to give more to missions and spend money on outreach to our own community. Continue working. If you see something that is important that I used to do but I'm not anymore, step up and do it. Or if it is a pastoral function, call it to my attention and don't just talk to others about it.

I am convinced that the work of Zion will continue, and the change will be hardly noticeable. In addition, we will be contributing to some very important work 20 miles to the south of us.

Jesus added two important things to His Commission. First, He has all authority. We do His work with His power under His control. Never forget that. Second, He is with us always. We don't work in a vacuum; we are partnered with the God of creation.

Under His leadership we will go forward, making disciples. We've done it for 139 years; we'll do that until Christ returns.

God bless your part in this new endeavor.
