What's in a name?

I think that most people today don't consider the meanings of names. Of our six kids, two were named after relatives, two were given names that we just liked, one was named after a man in the Bible, and one was given his name because of what it means. Nathan is the Hebrew word for gift.

What does your name mean? Glen means "a small valley." I don't think that my parents picked that because of the meaning.

The Bible is full of names that were full of meaning. Adam's wife was named Eve because she was the mother of all living. (By the way, Adam means "man.") God changed Abram's (exalted father) name to Abraham (the father of a multitude). Jacob's (he cheats) name was changed to Israel (he strives with God). Simon (to hear or be heard) to Peter (rock). There are others and they are significant.

When the angel spoke to Joseph, he told him to name Mary's son Jesus (to deliver or rescue) because "he will save his people from their sins."

When Jesus came, he preached and taught. He healed and loved. He rebuked and scolded. He wept. Those were all a part of who He is and what He came to do. But the core of His ministry, what He is all about, is salvation. Jesus came to save us, to deliver us from sin, death and the devil. Jesus came to die on the cross.

This month we celebrate His birth. But anytime we celebrate Jesus, we also celebrate His death. We are filled with joy that He came. We are filled with joy because He is our Savior.
